### Recommended Courses for STUDENTS Planning to Transfer to VWU

Students planning to transfer from Thomas Nelson Community College to Virginia Wesleyan University should complete courses that will satisfy VWU's major requirements and facilitate timely degree completion. Students who do not complete the required courses will have to complete additional courses, which may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. (Courses that are not required—they must be completed at the student's own expense.)
